13 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, line 11, strike the enacting clause

14 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, line 10 1/2, insert a new Section 2 to
15 read

16 "SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2001, Section 43, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 43. A. The board of county commissioners of any county
19 ~~with a population of two hundred thousand (200,000) or more~~
20 ~~according to the last Federal Decennial Census~~ may regulate or
21 prohibit the running at large of dogs within ~~said~~ that county, and
22 cause ~~such~~ the dogs ~~as may be~~ running at large to be ~~impounded and~~
23 disposed:

24 1. Impounded;

1 2. Disposed of as otherwise provided for by law; or ~~sold~~

2 3. Sold to discharge the costs and penalties provided for the
3 violation of ~~such~~ this prohibition and the expense of impounding and
4 keeping the same for such sale, ~~and~~.

5 The board of county commissioners may also provide for the
6 erection of all needful pens, pounds and buildings for the use of
7 ~~said~~ the county at any place within ~~said~~ the county.

8 B. It shall be the duty of the board of county commissioners of
9 any county undertaking the regulation and taxation of dogs in ~~said~~
10 the county under this ~~act~~ section to establish and enforce rules
11 governing the same, and they shall enter into a definite cooperative
12 agreement with the sheriff of ~~said~~ the county prescribing ~~said~~ the
13 rules and regulations and the manner and terms of enforcement
14 thereof, and for the financing and compensation therefor.

15 C. The board of county commissioners may also regulate and
16 provide for taxing the owners and harborers of dogs, and authorize
17 the humane killing or disposal of dogs, found at large, contrary to
18 any ordinance regulating the same.

19 D. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any rule or
20 regulation made by such board of county commissioners under the
21 authority of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be
22 punished as provided by the laws of this state in any court of
23 competent jurisdiction, provided that in the case of continuing
24

1 offenses, each day on which the offense occurs shall constitute a
2 separate offense."
