15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

17 "An Act relating to schools; creating the Zachary
Eckles and Luke Davis Automated External
18 Defibrillators in Schools Act; mandating that
automated external defibrillators be made available
19 at schools, if funding is available; authorizing
school districts to make automated external
20 defibrillators available at high school athletic
practices and competitions; providing certain
21 immunity from liability to school districts;
requiring the State Department of Education to
22 develop certain list and to provide public
recognition to certain organizations; providing for
23 codification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
3 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.200 of Title 70, unless
4 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

5 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Zachary
6 Eckles and Luke Davis Automated External Defibrillators in Schools
7 Act."

8 B. Contingent upon the availability of federal funding or
9 donations from private organizations or persons made for this
10 purpose, each school district shall make automated external
11 defibrillators, as defined in Section 5A of Title 76 of the Oklahoma
12 Statutes, available at each school site in the district. The school
13 district may also make automated external defibrillators available
14 at each high school athletic practice or competition in the
15 district.

16 C. Any school district that makes automated external
17 defibrillators available in schools or on school district property
18 shall be immune from civil liability for personal injury which
19 results from the use of the device, except for acts of gross
20 negligence or willfull wanton misconduct in accordance with Section
21 5A of Title 76 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

22 D. The State Department of Education shall develop and make
23 available to school districts a list of private organizations or
24 persons willing to make donations or that have resources available

1 to schools for this purpose, federal programs or grants, and any
2 other source of funding that school districts may use to purchase
3 automated external defibrillators. The Department shall also
4 provide public recognition for private organizations or persons that
5 provide funding to school districts for the purpose of purchasing
6 automated external defibrillators.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
