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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2001, Section 41.47, as
18 amended by Section 3, Chapter 301, O.S.L. 2003 (62 O.S. Supp. 2007,
19 Section 41.47), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 41.47 A. ~~There is hereby established the~~ The
21 Legislative Oversight Committee on State Budget Performance is
22 created, to continue until July 1, 2012, in accordance with the
23 provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The purposes of this
24 committee shall include oversight of the implementation of a system

1 of program performance-based budgeting for implementation by state
2 agencies.

3 B. The Committee's duties shall also include:

4 1. Development of agency budget request forms and instructions
5 in conjunction with the Office of State Finance;

6 2. Directing studies to aid in the development of legislative
7 and procedural changes to further improve the budgetary, financial,
8 accounting, reporting, personnel, and purchasing processes and
9 systems of the state;

10 3. Direction of program evaluation and management studies;

11 4. Oversight and reporting on executive branch compliance with
12 the legislative intent of appropriation measures. Such oversight
13 and reporting duties may include:

14 a. agency reorganization actions,

15 b. executive orders calling for reduction of full-time-
16 equivalents or hiring freezes, and

17 c. transfer of funds by the executive branch;

18 5. The development of revenue and expenditure estimates and
19 analyses;

20 6. Study of the management, operations, programs and fiscal
21 needs of the agencies and institutions of Oklahoma state government
22 pursuant to the Oklahoma Program Performance Budgeting and
23 Accountability Act;

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1 7. Review of the executive budget, agency strategic plans and
2 the estimate of needs of each state agency and institution. Reports
3 may be issued by the Committee as it deems appropriate; and

4 8. Implementation of an ongoing evaluation review procedure of
5 existing programs based on zero-base budgeting techniques pursuant
6 to the Oklahoma Program Performance Budgeting and Accountability
7 Act. The committee in cooperation with the Office of State Finance
8 shall establish a schedule to review strategic plans and existing
9 programs for each agency a minimum of once every four (4) years.

10 The committee shall issue an evaluation report for each agency once
11 every four (4) years which will include but not be limited to the
12 following information:

13 a. a review of the agency's programs, performance and
14 management,

15 b. whether the agency has demonstrated that there is a
16 need for the services and programs which justifies the
17 agency's continued existence,

18 c. whether the agency is the most appropriate provider of
19 the programs and services furnished by the agency.

20 C. Any reference in the Oklahoma Statutes to the Joint
21 Legislative Committee on Budget and Program Oversight shall be a
22 reference to the Legislative Oversight Committee on State Budget
23 Performance.

1 D. The Committee shall be composed of three members appointed
2 by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, three members appointed
3 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, two members by the
4 minority leader of the Senate and two members appointed by the
5 minority leader of the House of Representatives. The Chair and Vice
6 Chair of the Committee shall rotate every two (2) years between the
7 Senate and the House of Representatives beginning with a Senate
8 member serving as Chair in 2003. The Committee shall meet at least
9 four (4) times per year and at other times as called by the Chair.
10 The Legislative Oversight Committee on State Budget Performance
11 shall function as a committee of the Legislature when the
12 Legislature is in session and is not in session. Each member of the
13 Committee shall serve until a successor is appointed.

14 E. The Committee shall be staffed jointly by the staff of the
15 fiscal divisions of the Senate and the House of Representatives.

16 F. The Committee may make use of all available teleconferencing
17 technology to facilitate meetings of the Committee when the
18 Legislature is not in session. The Committee shall take any
19 appropriate action to make such teleconferenced meetings comply with
20 the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, Section 301 et seq.
21 of Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

22 G. The Committee shall periodically meet in different
23 geographical regions of the state to enhance the Committee's
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1 understanding of local conditions and to help educate the public as
2 to the fiscal condition of the state.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3907, as
4 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 208, O.S.L. 2006 (74 O.S. Supp.
5 2007, Section 3907), is amended to read as follows:

6 Section 3907. The following statutory entities and their
7 successors shall be terminated on July 1, 2012, and all powers,
8 duties and functions shall be abolished one (1) year thereafter:

9 1. Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and
10 Audiology as created by Section 1607 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
11 Statutes;

12 2. State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners as created by
13 Section 698.3 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 3. Board of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence as created by
15 Section 759 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 4. State Anatomical Board as created by Section 91 of Title 63
17 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

18 5. Oklahoma Peanut Commission as created by Section 18-52 of
19 Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

20 6. Oklahoma Wheat Utilization, Research and Market Development
21 Commission as created by Section 18-301 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes;

23 7. Board of Examiners in Optometry as created by Section 582 of
24 Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 8. State Capitol Preservation Commission as created by Section
2 4102 of this title;

3 9. Commission on County Government Personnel Education and
4 Training as created by Section 130.1 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma
5 Statutes;

6 10. Oklahoma Climatological Survey as created by Section 245 of
7 this title;

8 11. The State Board of Licensed Social Workers as created by
9 Section 1253 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 12. Child Death Review Board as created by Section 1150.2 of
11 Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 13. Oversight Committee for State Employee Charitable
13 Contributions as created by Section 7005 of this title;

14 14. The Wellness Council as created by Section 1382 of this
15 title;

16 15. Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Research, Marketing and
17 Safety Commission as created by Section 420.22 of Title 52 of the
18 Oklahoma Statutes;

19 16. Board of Chiropractic Examiners as created by Section 161.4
20 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 17. Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Board as created by Section 231
22 of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes; ~~and~~

23 18. State Board of Registration for Foresters as created by
24 Section 1203 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

1 19. Legislative Oversight Committee on State Budget Performance
2 as created by Section 41.47 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

4 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
