Page 1, Line 12, after the semi-colon ";" and before the word "and" by inserting the language "directing the State Department of Health and the State Department of Education to facilitate development of a physical fitness assessment software program; specifying capabilities of program; providing for selection of schools to pilot program; stating purpose of pilot program; providing for codification;"
