Amendments:

1. Page 7 line 23, by deleting after the word "the" and before the word "fingerprinting", all language.
2. Page 8 lines 2 and 3, by deleting after the word "be" on line 2 and before the word "fingerprinted" on line 3 all language.
3. Page 8 line 4, by inserting after the semicolon ";" the word "and".
4. Page 8 lines 5 and 6, by deleting all of paragraph 2 and renumbering subsequent paragraphs.

5. Page 8 line 7, by deleting before the word “the” all language and inserting the words “Dispose of”.
6. Page 8 line 7, by deleting after the word “information” and before the word “of” all language.
7. Page 8 line 8, by deleting after the word “taken” and before the word “one” all language and inserting the word “within”.
8. By striking the title and inserting:
“(Children – duties and powers of the Oklahoma Department of Human Services – effective date)”
