11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to higher education; placing
13 supervision of the Will Rogers Memorial and Homesite
14 under the Board of Regents of the University of
15 Oklahoma; directing the Will Rogers Memorial
16 Commission to form a Will Rogers Memorial Advisory
17 Committee; stating purpose of the Advisory Committee;
18 providing for membership; providing for travel
19 reimbursement; requiring the Advisory Committee to
20 submit a report by certain date; providing for
21 codification; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 47.9 of Title 53, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. Effective July 1, 2008, the operation of the Will Rogers
2 Memorial and the Will Rogers Homesite shall be under the direction
3 and supervision of the Board of Regents of the University of
4 Oklahoma.

5 B. 1. By August 1, 2007, the Will Rogers Memorial Commission
6 shall form a Will Rogers Memorial Advisory Committee. The purpose
7 of the Advisory Committee shall be to study and make recommendations
8 on the transfer of the administration, property, monies, and
9 employees of the Will Rogers Memorial Commission to the Board of
10 Regents of the University of Oklahoma.

11 2. Members of the Advisory Committee shall be selected by the
12 Commission. Members of the Advisory Committee shall represent the
13 Will Rogers Memorial, the City of Claremore, Rogers State
14 University, and the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma.
15 Members shall receive no compensation for serving on the Advisory
16 Committee but shall be reimbursed for necessary travel expenses
17 incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with the
18 State Travel Reimbursement Act.

19 3. The Advisory Committee shall submit a report of its findings
20 and recommendations to the Governor and Legislature by January 31,
21 2008.

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
