11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to public finance; authorizing the  
13 Office of State Finance to enter into certain  
14 agreement; exempting action from The Oklahoma Central  
15 Purchasing Act; providing for area of authorized  
16 facility; authorizing use of certain funds to finance  
17 facilities; providing for codification; and providing  
18 an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 41.5x of Title 62, unless there  
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The Office of State Finance is authorized to enter into a multi-  
24 year agreement to acquire land, develop, design, construct and  
furnish facilities necessary for the administration of the state's

1 information technology and telecommunications infrastructure and  
2 security. Such action shall not be subject to The Oklahoma Central  
3 Purchasing Act. The area of the facility authorized by this section  
4 dedicated for computer-ready space shall not exceed ten percent  
5 (10%) of the total square footage of the entire facility, but under  
6 no circumstances shall exceed nine thousand (9,000) square feet.  
7 The Office of State Finance is authorized to use existing and future  
8 funds from fees, appropriations and federal funds, as necessary, to  
9 finance such facilities.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2007.
