11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
13 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
14 amounts; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees; providing budgetary limitations;
16 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budgeting
17 practices; prohibiting certain budgeting practices;
18 providing an effective date; and declaring an
19 emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, the
22 Corporation Commission shall budget all funds in the following
23 categories and amounts:

12 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the Corporation Commission by law shall be set by the
15 Corporation Commission. The Corporation Commission shall be subject
16 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
17 employees and expenditures excluding direct expenditures for well
18 plugging as authorized in Section 310 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma
19 Statutes, pit closure as authorized in Section 140 of Title 52 of
20 the Oklahoma Statutes, and remediation of sites as authorized in
21 Section 353 of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as may be
22 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
23 the Oklahoma Statutes:

3 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Section 93 of Enrolled Senate
4 Bill No. 334 of the 1st Regular Session of the 51st Oklahoma
5 Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay
6 purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008
7 (hereafter FY-08) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June
8 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09). Funds budgeted for FY-08 may be
9 encumbered only through June 30, 2008, and must be expended by
10 November 15, 2008. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2008, and
11 not budgeted for FY-09, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund
12 for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be
13 encumbered only through June 30, 2009. Any funds remaining after
14 November 15, 2009, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for
15 the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be
16 budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-
17 08, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be
18 budgeted for FY-09, after the agency to which the funds have been
19 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
20 revision removing these funds from the FY-08 budget work program and
21 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State
22 Finance.

23 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007.

1 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
