11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to Oklahoma Capitol Complex and  
13 Centennial Commemoration Commission; directing the  
14 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration  
15 Commission to submit a financial report by a certain  
16 date; specifying contents of the report; providing  
17 for the transfer of the rights and responsibilities  
18 of the Commission to the Oklahoma Department of  
19 Commerce upon certain date; specifying transfer of  
20 all properties, liabilities, fund balances,  
21 encumbrances and obligations; providing for  
22 codification; and providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.7 of Title 73, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1           A. The Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration  
2 Commission shall submit a financial report of the activities of the  
3 Commission to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of  
4 Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate by  
5 March 31, 2008. The financial report shall include a summary and  
6 accounting of all centennial projects and activities funded by the  
7 Commission, the final budget for the Commission, a list of any  
8 outstanding or anticipated obligations, and the anticipated balance  
9 of any monies remaining after July 1, 2008, in any funds designated  
10 for the Commission.

11           B. Upon termination of the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and  
12 Centennial Commemoration Commission on July 1, 2008, any remaining  
13 rights and responsibilities of the Commission, including the rights  
14 and responsibilities of the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
15 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of  
16 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be transferred to the  
17 Oklahoma Department of Commerce. The transfer shall include all  
18 property, furniture, equipment, supplies, records, current and  
19 future liabilities, fund balances, encumbrances, obligations, and  
20 indebtedness associated with the Commission on July 1, 2008.

21           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2008.
