10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
12 amending Section 2, Chapter 157, O.S.L. 2005 (69 O.S.
13 Supp. 2006, Section 1681), which relates to
14 designating a section of State Highway 54 as the 2nd
15 Lt. Luke James Memorial Highway; designating a
16 section of State Highway 54 as the Senator Byron
17 Dacus Memorial Highway; requiring placement of
18 markers; designating a section of U.S. Highway 60 as
19 the Donald J. Gott Memorial Highway; requiring
20 placement of markers; designating a certain bridge as
21 the Harley Leaird Memorial Bridge; requiring
22 placement of markers; designating a certain bridge as
23 the Joseph Sevier Memorial Bridge; requiring
24 placement of markers; designating a certain bridge as
the Lonnie Duke Memorial Bridge; requiring placement
of markers; designating a section of State Highway
136 as the Spc. Joshua Pearce Memorial Highway;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 157, O.S.L.
2 2005 (69 O.S. Supp. 2006, Section 1681), is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Section 1681. The section of State Highway 54 extending from
5 the municipal limits of Optima to the Kansas state line shall be
6 designated as the "2nd Lt. Luke James Memorial Highway". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 to be placed upon that section of highway bearing that name.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.12 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 State Highway 54 beginning at the junction with State Highway
13 152 and extending to the junction with State Highway 62 shall be
14 designated as the "Senator Byron Dacus Memorial Highway". The
15 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
16 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

17 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.13 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The portion of U.S. Highway 60 between Arnett, Oklahoma, and
21 Harmon, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Donald J. Gott
22 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
23 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
24 name.

1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.14 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge across Clear Boggy Creek, which is located on State
5 Highway 31, approximately 3.2 miles east of the intersection of
6 State Highway 31 and State Highway 48 shall be designated as the
7 "Harley Leaird Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
8 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge
9 bearing that name.

10 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.15 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge located on State Highway 31, approximately 2.8 miles
14 east of the intersection of State Highway 31 and State Highway 48
15 shall be designated as the "Joseph Sevier Memorial Bridge". The
16 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
17 to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

18 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.16 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge located on State Highway 31, approximately 2.5 miles
22 east of the intersection of State Highway 31 and State Highway 48
23 shall be designated as the "Lonnie Duke Memorial Bridge". The
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1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

3 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 69 of Title 1698.17, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of State Highway 136 extending north from the
7 junction of State Highway 136 and State Highway 3 to the Kansas
8 state line shall be designated as the "Spc. Joshua Pearce Memorial
9 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
10 permanent markers to be placed upon that section of highway bearing
11 that name.

12 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.

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
