11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the State Board of Education;
13 making appropriations to the State Board of
14 Education; stating purposes; making appropriations
15 nonfiscal; making appropriations exempt from certain
16 agency category and budget limits; and declaring an
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
20 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2007, the sum of Twenty-seven Million Seven Hundred
23 Ten Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-four Dollars (\$27,710,534.00) or so

1 much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public
2 schools.

3 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
4 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
5 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
6 ending June 30, 2007, the sum of Sixteen Million One Hundred
7 Thousand Dollars (\$16,100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary to be transferred to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and which
9 shall be deposited in the Ad Valorem Reimbursement Fund created
10 pursuant to Section 193 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the
11 purpose of reimbursing counties for school districts that claim a
12 loss of revenue due to a tax exemption granted for a new or expanded
13 manufacturing or research and development facility pursuant to the
14 provisions of Section 6B of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution.

15 SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be
16 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
17 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
18 months from the date this act is approved.

19 SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall not be
20 subject to fiscal years 2008 and 2009 agency category and budget
21 limits.

22 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
