11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Council on Judicial  
13 Complaints; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
14 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
15 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
16 providing budgetary limitations; limiting salary of  
17 the Director; providing lapse dates; requiring and  
18 prohibiting certain budget practices; providing an  
19 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
20 Council on Judicial Complaints shall budget all funds in the  
21 following categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each  
2 budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law shall be set by the  
6 Director of the Council on Judicial Complaints. The salary of the  
7 Director of the Council on Judicial Complaints shall not exceed  
8 Eighty-two Thousand Three Hundred Forty-one Dollars (\$82,341.00) per  
9 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.  
10 The Council on Judicial Complaints for the fiscal year ending June  
11 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
12 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding  
13 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
14 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
15 the Oklahoma Statutes:

18 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Section 118 of Enrolled House  
19 Bill No. 2276 of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature,  
20 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may  
21 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-  
22 09) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010  
23 (hereafter FY-10). Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only  
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1 through June 30, 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009.  
2 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for  
3 FY-10, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
4 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered  
5 only through June 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15,  
6 2010, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
7 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in  
8 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not  
9 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted  
10 for FY-10, after the agency to which the funds have been  
11 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
12 revision removing these funds from the FY-09 budget work program and  
13 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State  
14 Finance.

15 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

16 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
