11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Scenic Rivers Commission;  
13 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
14 amounts; providing for duties and compensation of  
15 employees; limiting salary of Administrator;  
16 providing budgetary limitations; making certain  
17 employee positions contingent upon receipt of grant  
18 funds; directing certain transfer; providing lapse  
19 dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget  
20 procedures; providing an effective date; and  
21 declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Scenic  
24 Rivers Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories  
and amounts:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
General Operations	\$345,322.00	\$1,500,000.00

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 3 upon the Scenic Rivers Commission by law shall be set by the  
 4 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission. The salary of the  
 5 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission shall not exceed  
 6 Forty-nine Thousand Seventy-eight Dollars (\$49,078.00) per annum,  
 7 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The  
 8 Scenic Rivers Commission, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009,  
 9 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-  
 10 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures  
 11 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized  
 12 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
 13 Oklahoma Statutes:

19 SECTION 3. Of the ten (10.0) full-time-equivalent employee  
 20 positions authorized in this act, two (2.0) full-time-equivalent  
 21 employee positions shall be filled contingent upon receipt of grant  
 22 funds for the purposes set forth in Section 1461 of Title 82 of the  
 23 Oklahoma Statutes which establishes the Scenic Rivers Commission.

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1           SECTION 4.           TRANSFER           The Scenic Rivers Commission shall  
2 transfer the sum of Three Hundred Forty-five Thousand Three Hundred  
3 Twenty-two Dollars (\$345,322.00) from the funds appropriated in  
4 Section 129 of Enrolled House Bill Number No. 2276 of the 2nd  
5 Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature to the Scenic Rivers  
6 Commission Revolving Fund for the Illinois River, Flint Creek and  
7 Barren Fork Creek established pursuant to Section 1462A of Title 82  
8 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.

9           SECTION 5. Appropriations made by Section 129 of Enrolled House  
10 Bill No. 2276 of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature,  
11 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may  
12 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-  
13 09) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010  
14 (hereafter FY-10). Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only  
15 through June 30, 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009.  
16 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for  
17 FY-10, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
18 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered  
19 only through June 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15,  
20 2010, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
21 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in  
22 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not  
23 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted  
24 for FY-10, after the agency to which the funds have been

1 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
2 revision removing these funds from the FY-09 budget work program and  
3 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State  
4 Finance.

5 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

6 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
