10 An Act relating to public safety; amending 47 O.S.
11 2001, Section 11-1402, as last amended by Section 17,
12 Chapter 418, O.S.L. 2004 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section
13 11-1402), which relates to enforcement of laws on
14 turnpikes; authorizing state agencies to enter into
15 written agreements for certain law enforcement duties
16 on turnpikes; providing time limitation for making
17 certain request; designating responsibility of costs
18 to state agency making request; and providing an
19 effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-1402, as
22 last amended by Section 17, Chapter 418, O.S.L. 2004 (47 O.S. Supp.
23 2007, Section 11-1402), is amended to read as follows:

24 Section 11-1402. A. Except as otherwise provided ~~herein~~ in
this section, enforcement of both traffic laws and the general laws
of the State of Oklahoma on the turnpikes shall be the exclusive
authority of the Department of Public Safety, and the cost thereof

1 shall be borne by the Oklahoma Transportation Authority. Provided
2 that the Authority shall be liable only for such costs as may be
3 agreed to by it under contract or agreement with the Commissioner of
4 Public Safety.

5 B. Upon a written request by a state agency to the Commissioner
6 of Public Safety, the Department of Public Safety, upon the approval
7 of the Commissioner of Public Safety, may enter into a written
8 agreement with the state agency permitting that state agency to
9 perform on the turnpikes of this state those law enforcement duties
10 specified in the agreement. The request by the state agency must be
11 acted upon by the Commissioner within sixty (60) days of receiving
12 such request. The costs of performing those law enforcement duties
13 shall be the responsibility of the state agency making the written
14 request and no costs shall be the responsibility of the Oklahoma
15 Turnpike Authority or the Department of Public Safety.

16 C. On the turnpikes, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
17 shall have the authority to investigate and enforce all laws
18 relating to any crime listed as an exception to the definition of
19 "nonviolent offense" as set forth in section 571 of Title 57 of the
20 Oklahoma Statutes.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
