11 An Act relating to amusements and sports; requiring  
12 certain reports; amending 3A O.S. 2001, Section  
13 205.2a, which relates to organization licenses;  
14 clarifying language; providing for noncodification;  
15 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
16 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20 The Oklahoma Lottery Commission shall provide the Oklahoma  
21 Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee not later than  
22 September 1 of each year with a report of all new and deleted  
23 lottery games offered or withdrawn during the previous fiscal year.

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1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 3A O.S. 2001, Section 205.2a, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 205.2a Whenever an organization license to conduct a  
4 horse race meeting has been issued, no person shall in any manner  
5 become the owner or holder, directly or indirectly, of any shares of  
6 stock or certificates or other evidence of ownership of any interest  
7 in such organization licensee without first having obtained the  
8 approval of the Commission. The Commission may, after a hearing,  
9 revoke such organization license granted to any person which shall  
10 register on its books in the name of any person its shares of stock  
11 or certificates or other evidence of ownership of any interest in  
12 such organization licensee without the approval of the Commission  
13 having first been obtained, or which shall knowingly permit a person  
14 to be directly or indirectly interested in its shares of stock or  
15 certificates or other evidence of ownership of any interest in such  
16 organization license without reporting the same to the Commission.  
17 Whenever the Commission gives to any person its approval to own or  
18 hold the shares of stock or certificates or other evidence of  
19 ownership of any interest in any such organization licensee it shall  
20 by registered mail notify the secretary of such licensee of such  
21 approval. Under no circumstances shall the Commission give such  
22 approval to any person who has been convicted of a felony or a crime  
23 involving moral turpitude, unless said person has been granted a  
24 full and unconditional pardon. Under no circumstances shall the

1 Commission give such approval to any person who has violated any of  
2 the provisions of the racing laws of this state or any other state,  
3 or has at any time been denied a license or permit of any kind by  
4 the Commission.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
