11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement
12 Authority; requiring certain reports; amending 73
13 O.S. 2001, Section 151, which relates to the Oklahoma
14 Capitol Improvement Authority; clarifying language;
15 providing for noncodification; providing an effective
16 date; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20 The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority shall annually
21 provide a report to the House of Representatives and the Senate
22 identifying active leases related to outstanding obligations of the
23 Authority.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2001, Section 151, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 151. The purpose of this act is to provide adequate and
4 suitable space for offices and other necessary uses for all
5 departments and agencies of ~~the~~ this state, particularly the ones
6 now paying or which hereafter may be required to pay rent, and for
7 the purpose of increasing the efficiency of the operation of state
8 departments and agencies, and to eventually cause the State of
9 Oklahoma to receive all the benefit of the rents now being paid by
10 state departments and agencies. It shall also be the purpose of
11 this act to provide an improved and expanded highway infrastructure
12 for the health, safety, and welfare of the traveling public in this
13 state and for the continued economic development of this state.

14 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007.

15 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
