8 An Act relating to public health and safety; making
9 it unlawful for a state employee to perform an
10 abortion; providing for exceptions; making it
11 unlawful for state funds to be used to encourage
12 abortion with exception; providing for codification;
13 and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-737.1 of Title 63, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. It shall be unlawful for any person employed by this state
19 or any agency or political subdivision thereof, within the scope of
20 the employment, to perform or assist an abortion not necessary to
21 save the life of the mother. It shall be unlawful for any public
22 institution, public facility, public equipment, or any physical
23 asset owned, leased, or controlled by this state, or any agency or
24 political subdivisions thereof to be used for the purpose of

1 performing or assisting an abortion not necessary to save the life
2 of the mother. This section shall not be construed to prohibit use
3 by private entities of public utilities or the services of
4 firefighters or police.

5 B. It shall be unlawful for any funds received or controlled by
6 this state or any agency or political subdivision thereof including,
7 but not limited to, funds derived from federal, state, or local
8 taxes, gifts or grants, from any source, public or private, federal
9 grants or payments, or intergovernmental transfers, to be used to
10 encourage a female to have an abortion not necessary to save her
11 life, except to the extent required for continued participation in a
12 federal program.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
