8 An Act relating to public health and safety;
9 requiring certain agreement with hospital for
10 ambulatory surgical centers; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2666 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 An ambulatory surgical center shall have a formal transfer
18 agreement with a general hospital, as defined in Section 1-701 of
19 Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, located not more than a twenty-
20 minute travel distance from the center, or all physicians performing
21 surgery in the ambulatory surgical center shall have admitting
22 privileges at a general hospital, located not more than a twenty-
23 minute travel distance from the center.
