14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.6a, as  
16 last amended by Section 10, Chapter 83, 2nd Extraordinary Session,  
17 O.S.L. 2006 (74 O.S. Supp. 2006, Section 150.6a), is amended to read  
18 as follows:

19 Section 150.6a A. Effective July 1, 2004, the annual salaries  
20 for the Deputy Director, and the positions within the Oklahoma State  
21 Bureau of Investigation, as set out in this section, shall be in  
22 accordance and conformity with the following salary schedule,  
23 exclusive of longevity pay as authorized by Section 840-2.18 of this  
24 title:

1        1. Deputy Director:

2                The salary of the Deputy Director shall be  
3                ninety-five percent (95%) of that received  
4                by the Director;

5        2. Division Director:

6                The salary of a Division Director shall be  
7                ninety percent (90%) of that received by  
8                the Director;

9        3. Agent I (OSBI), Criminalist I:

10                Minimum \$33,500.00, Mid-point \$41,875.00,  
11                Maximum \$50,250.00;

12        4. Agent II (OSBI), Criminalist II:

13                Minimum \$39,250.00, Mid-point \$49,062.00,  
14                Maximum \$58,875.00;

15        5. Agent III (OSBI), Criminalist III:

16                Minimum \$46,250.00, Mid-point \$57,812.00,  
17                Maximum \$69,375.00;

18        6. Agent IV (OSBI), Criminalist IV:

19                Minimum \$51,000.00, Mid-point \$63,750.00,  
20                Maximum \$76,500.00; and

21        7. Agent V (OSBI), Criminalist V:

22                Minimum \$56,000.00, Mid-point \$70,000.00,  
23                Maximum \$84,000.00.

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1 B. Effective July 1, 2004, positions allocated to the agent and  
2 criminalist job families may receive additional compensation through  
3 the use of pay mechanisms provided for in the Oklahoma Personnel Act  
4 and the Merit System of Personnel Administration Rules.

5 C. Effective ~~January~~ July 1, 2007, the annual salaries for the  
6 ~~Deputy~~ Director, and the positions within the Oklahoma State Bureau  
7 of Investigation, as set out in this section, shall be in accordance  
8 and conformity with the following salary schedule, exclusive of  
9 longevity pay as authorized by Section 840-2.18 of this title:

10 1. Director: ~~\$80,138.10~~ \$96,812.00;

11 2. Deputy Director:

12 The salary of the Deputy Director shall be ninety-five  
13 percent (95%) of that received by the Director;

14 3. Division Director:

15 The salary of a Division Director shall be ninety percent  
16 (90%) of that received by the Director;

17 4. Agent I (OSBI), Criminalist I:

18 Minimum \$35,600.00, Mid-point \$43,975.00,  
19 Maximum \$52,350.00;

20 5. Agent II (OSBI), Criminalist II:

21 Minimum \$41,350.00, Mid-point \$51,162.00,  
22 Maximum \$60,975.00;

23 6. Agent III (OSBI), Criminalist III:

24 Minimum \$51,980.00, Mid-point \$63,542.00,

1 Maximum \$75,105.00;

2 7. Agent IV (OSBI), Criminalist IV:

3 Minimum \$60,615.00, Mid-point \$73,365.00,

4 Maximum \$86,115.00; and

5 8. Agent V (OSBI), Criminalist V:

6 Minimum \$66,386.00, Mid-point \$80,386.00,

7 Maximum \$94,386.00.

8 Provided, however, no such employee shall receive less than the  
9 salary the employee received on December 31, 2006.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
