13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 2220.5, as
15 amended by Section 4, Chapter 395, O.S.L. 2004 (63 O.S. Supp. 2006,
16 Section 2220.5), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 2220.5 A. 1. ~~An~~ The Commissioner of Public Safety
18 shall inquire, in writing, on the electronic signature pad of the
19 motor license agent, if any applicant for an original or replacement
20 driver license or identification card ~~shall be given an opportunity~~
21 would like to make a voluntary contribution of One Dollar (\$1.00) to
22 be credited to the Oklahoma Organ Donor Education and Awareness
23 Program Revolving Fund established in Section 2220.3 of this title.
24 Any voluntary contribution shall be added to the driver license or

1 identification card fee and then be referred to the State Treasurer
2 and credited to the Oklahoma Organ Donor Education and Awareness
3 Program Revolving Fund as provided in Section 2220.3 of this title.

4 2. An applicant for a vehicle title or transfer of title or for
5 a vehicle license plate shall be given an opportunity, in writing,
6 to make a minimum voluntary contribution of One Dollar (\$1.00) to be
7 credited to the Oklahoma Organ Donor Education and Awareness Program
8 Revolving Fund established in Section 2220.3 of this title. Any
9 voluntary contribution shall be added to the title or license plate
10 fee and then be referred to the State Treasurer and credited to the
11 Oklahoma Organ Donor Education and Awareness Program Revolving Fund
12 as provided in Section 2220.3 of this title.

13 3. The contribution prescribed in this section is voluntary and
14 may be refused by the applicant. The Department of Public Safety
15 and the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall make available an information
16 booklet or other informational sources on the importance of organ
17 donation to applicants for licensure, as designed and provided by
18 the State Department of Health and the State Superintendent of
19 Public Instruction with the assistance of the Oklahoma Organ Donor
20 Education and Awareness Program Advisory Council established in
21 Section 2220.2 of this title.

22 B. The Department of Public Safety and motor license agents
23 shall inquire of each applicant at the time of presentation of a
24 completed application for an original driver license or

1 identification card whether the applicant is interested in making
2 the One Dollar (\$1.00) contribution prescribed in subsection A of
3 this section and whether the applicant is interested in being an
4 organ and tissue donor, in writing, on the electronic signature pad
5 of the motor license agent. The Department of Public Safety or
6 motor license agents shall also specifically inform the applicant of
7 the ability to make an organ and tissue donation. The Department of
8 Public Safety shall notify the State Commissioner of Health the
9 name, address, date of birth, and driver license number or
10 identification card number of applicants who indicate that they are
11 interested in being an organ donor.

12 C. The incremental cost of administration of contributions to
13 the fund, not to exceed one percent (1%) of the monies received
14 pursuant to the provisions of this section, shall be paid by the
15 fund to the Department of Public Safety or the Oklahoma Tax
16 Commission, as applicable, from amounts received pursuant to the
17 provisions of this section before funds are expended for the
18 purposes of the fund.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
