12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9, Chapter 375, O.S.L.  
14 2003 (70 O.S. Supp. 2006, Section 821.89), is amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 Section 821.89 A. ~~An~~ Except as provided in subsection E of  
17 this section, an application for registration or renewal of  
18 registration must be accompanied by a fee in the following amount:

19 1. One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for an initial application  
20 for registration;

21 2. One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for an application for  
22 registration based upon a certificate of registration or licensure  
23 issued by another state;

1           3. One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for an application for  
2 renewal of registration; or

3           4. One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for an application for  
4 renewal of registration based upon an application for renewal of  
5 registration or licensure submitted in another state.

6           B. For the initial registration, the Secretary of State shall  
7 credit against the fee required by subsection A of this section the  
8 prorated value of any filing fee paid by an athlete agent for  
9 registration as an athlete agent prior to January 1, 2004, for the  
10 time from January 1, 2004, until the date the prior registration  
11 would have expired.

12           C. The Secretary of State shall return any surety bond deposit  
13 filed with the Secretary of State by an athlete agent prior to  
14 January 1, 2004.

15           D. All registration fees collected pursuant to this section  
16 shall be deposited in the Revolving Fund for the Office of the  
17 Secretary of State.

18           E. Any attorney licensed to practice law in this state shall be  
19 exempt from the payment of any fee provided for in subsection A of  
20 this section.

21           SECTION 2.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 821.100 of Title 70, unless  
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       A. The Legislature finds that for the purpose of promoting the  
2 welfare of student-athletes and preventing abuses by athlete agents,  
3 it is desirable that all Oklahoma school districts and all Oklahoma  
4 institutions of higher education develop and implement curriculum to  
5 educate students between fourteen (14) and twenty-two (22) years of  
6 age who are or will become student-athletes, as defined by Section  
7 821.82 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, about athlete agents.

8       B. The curriculum shall include, but not be limited to,  
9 lectures, mentoring programs, manuals, workbooks, brochures, and  
10 multimedia presentations that provide information about the role of  
11 the athlete agent, permissible activities when dealing with athlete  
12 agents, and acts which are prohibited.

13       SECTION 3. This act shall become effective January 1, 2008.
