8 An Act relating to cities and towns; mandating
9 training for certain municipal employees; providing
10 exception; providing for codification; and providing
11 an effective date.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-111.1 of Title 11, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Municipal employees assigned to enforce municipal codes with
18 nuisance abatements including, but not limited to, cleaning and
19 mowing of property, condemnation of dilapidated buildings and
20 graffiti removal shall complete certification training applicable to
21 duties as a code enforcement officer. The training shall be
22 administered by a statewide organization that represents
23 municipalities and has statutory functions and has conducted
24 training programs for municipalities for at least fifteen (15) years

1 in conjunction with the Oklahoma Code Enforcement Association. Such
2 certification training shall be completed within one (1) year of
3 employment. This section shall not apply to code enforcement
4 officers employed on or before November 1, 2007.

5 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-112.3 of Title 11, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 Municipal employees assigned to enforce provisions of Sections
9 22-112, 22-112.1 and 22-112.2 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes
10 shall complete certification training specifically applicable to
11 such sections as adopted and administered by the Oklahoma Code
12 Enforcement Association, an internationally recognized model code
13 organization, an institution of vocational and technical education,
14 or an institution of higher education. The certification training
15 shall be completed within one (1) year of employment or assignment.

16 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
