15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.196 of Title 70, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Beginning with the 2008-2009 school year, the parent or
20 guardian of each student enrolled in second grade and eighth grade
21 at a public school in the state shall provide by the first day of
22 the school year certification of a completed physical examination to
23 school personnel. The physical examination shall have been
24 completed within the previous twelve (12) months. The parent or

1 guardian of a student who does not have certification of a completed
2 physical examination by the first day of school shall have ninety
3 calendar (90) days in which to submit the certification.

4 B. The physical examination required in subsection A of this
5 section shall be conducted by a licensed physician or by an
6 authorized representative of the State Department of Health. The
7 physical examination shall include but shall not be limited to:

- 8 1. A health history;
- 9 2. Vision and hearing evaluation;
- 10 3. Hematocrit or hemoglobin tests;
- 11 4. Measurement of blood pressure;
- 12 5. Measurement of height and weight;
- 13 6. Asthma screening; and
- 14 7. Diabetes screening.

15 C. A student shall be exempt from the physical examination
16 requirements of subsection A of this section if the parent or
17 guardian of the student submits a written statement declaring that:

- 18 1. The physical examination conflicts with the moral or
19 religious tenets of the student or the parent or guardian of the
20 student; or
- 21 2. The parent or guardian of the student objects to the
22 physical examination of the student.

23 D. School districts shall notify parents or guardians of
24 students who enroll in second or eighth grade for the 2008-2009

1 school year and each school year thereafter of the requirements of
2 this section.

3 E. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules necessary to
4 carry out the provisions of this section.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
