8 An Act relating to state government; authorizing
9 state agencies to establish a wellness program for
10 employees; providing for certain limitations;
11 providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1385 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 In an effort to improve the health status of Oklahomans, any
18 state agency is authorized to establish and maintain a health and
19 wellness program for employees of the agency. This program shall be
20 limited to the criteria required to become a certified healthy
21 business as determined by the State Department of Health.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
