8 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
9 designating portion of U.S. Highway 177 as the Staff
10 Sergeant Billy M. Castleberry Memorial Highway;
11 providing for placement of permanent markers;
12 designating certain bridge on State Highway 31 as the
13 PFC Glen W. Page Memorial Bridge; providing for
14 placement of permanent markers; designating certain
15 bridge on State Highway 31 as the Pvt. Everett C.
16 (Bud) Ward Memorial Bridge; providing for placement
17 of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on
18 State Highway 97 as the OHP Lt. Pat Grimes Memorial
19 Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers;
20 designating certain bridge on U.S. Highway 60 as the
21 P.O.W./M.I.A. Memorial Bridge; providing for
22 placement of permanent markers; designating certain
23 bridge on State Highway 7 as the PFC Danny Leo Evans
24 Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent
markers; designating certain bridge on State Highway
7 as the SPC4 Benny Joe Lewis Memorial Bridge;
providing for placement of permanent markers;
designating a section of State Highway 251A as the
Kelly Downing Memorial Highway; providing for
placement of permanent markers; designating a section
of U.S. Highway 83 as the Oklahoma Panhandle Vietnam
Veterans Memorial Highway; providing for placement of
permanent markers; designating certain bridge on U.S.
Highway 77 as the Cpl. Bryan J. Scripsick Memorial
Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers;
designating a section of U.S. Highway 69 as the
Veterans Memorial Highway; providing for placement of
markers; providing for codification; and declaring an
emergency.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
3 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless
4 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

5 U.S. Highway 177, where it passes through Johnston County, shall
6 be designated as the "Staff Sergeant Billy M. Castleberry Memorial
7 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
8 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge across Salt Creek, currently known as the "salt
13 creek" bridge, located on State Highway 31 south of Ashland,
14 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "PFC Glen W. Page Memorial
15 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
16 permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

17 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.20 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The bridge located where State Highway 31 crosses Keel Creek
21 northeast of Coalgate, Oklahoma, and near Cairo, Oklahoma, shall be
22 designated as the "Pvt. Everett C. (Bud) Ward Memorial Bridge". The
23 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
24 to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.21 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge located where State Highway 97 crosses the Arkansas
5 River in Sand Springs, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "OHP Lt.
6 Pat Grimes Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
7 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge
8 bearing that name.

9 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.22 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge located where U.S. Highway 60 crosses the Arkansas
13 River in Ponca City, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
14 "P.O.W./M.I.A. Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
15 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge
16 bearing that name.

17 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.23 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The bridge located where State Highway 7 crosses the western
21 portion of Clear Boggy Creek in Atoka County shall be designated as
22 the "PFC Danny Leo Evans Memorial Bridge". The Department of
23 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
24 upon the bridge bearing that name.

1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.24 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge located where State Highway 7 crosses the eastern
5 portion of Clear Boggy Creek in Atoka County shall be designated as
6 the "SPC4 Benny Joe Lewis Memorial Bridge". The Department of
7 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
8 upon the bridge bearing that name.

9 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.25 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The section of State Highway 251A in Wagoner County extending
13 from the junction of State Highway 251A and State Highway 16 east to
14 Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Kelly Downing Memorial
15 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
16 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

17 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.26 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of U.S. Highway 83 in Beaver County extending from
21 the Kansas state line to the Texas state line shall be designated as
22 the "Oklahoma Panhandle Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway". The
23 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
24 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.27 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The "Washita River Bridge" located on U.S. Highway 77 in Garvin
5 County shall be known as the "Cpl. Bryan J. Scripsick Memorial
6 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
7 permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

8 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.28 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 U.S. Highway 69 from South 760 county road extending north to
12 South 690 county road in Wagoner County shall be designated as
13 "Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
14 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
15 that name.

16 SECTION 12. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
