14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 A. The Legislative Service Bureau shall contract for an
18 independent performance audit of the Human Services Centers in the
19 Department of Human Services including, but not limited to, the
20 Family Support Services Division, the Children and Family Services
21 Division, the Field Operations Division and all area and county
22 offices included therein. The audit shall be a comprehensive review
23 of the agency's operations in the Human Services Centers and shall
24 include, but not be limited to, a primary focus on:

- 1 1. Improving efficiency in management and structure;
- 2 2. Eliminating barriers in communications;
- 3 3. Reducing employee turnover;
- 4 4. Examining compensation-related issues;
- 5 5. Determining optimal training programs; and
- 6 6. Improving outcomes for individuals and families served by
- 7 the agency.

8 B. Upon completion of the audit, a final report with
9 recommendations shall be submitted to the Governor, the Speaker of
10 the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore
11 of the State Senate.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

13 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
