7 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
9 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-301, which relates to vital
10 statistics; defining terms; creating the Missing
11 Angels Act - Christopher and Kendall's Law; providing
12 for establishment of certificate of birth resulting
13 in stillbirth; specifying conditions for issuance;
14 providing for name of stillborn child; specifying
15 time for issuance of certificate; providing for
16 delay; providing for codification; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-301, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1-301. As used in this article:

22 1. "Vital statistics" means records of birth, death, fetal
23 death and data related thereto;

24 2. "System of vital statistics" means the registration,
collection, preservation, amendment and certification of vital
statistics records, and activities related thereto, including the

1 tabulation, analysis and publication of statistical data derived
2 from such records;

3 3. "Filing" means the presentation of a certificate, report or
4 other record provided for in this article, of a birth, death, fetal
5 death or adoption, for registration by the State Commissioner of
6 Health;

7 4. "Registration" means the acceptance by the State
8 Commissioner of Health and the incorporation in his official records
9 of certificates, reports or other records provided for in this
10 article, of births, deaths, fetal deaths or adoptions;

11 5. "Live birth" means the complete expulsion or extraction from
12 ~~its~~ the mother of a product of human conception, irrespective of the
13 duration of pregnancy, which, after such expulsion or extraction,
14 breathes or shows any other evidence of life such as beating of the
15 heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord or definite movement of
16 voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or
17 the placenta is attached;

18 6. "Stillbirth" or "stillborn child" means an unintended
19 intrauterine fetal death after a gestational age of twenty (20)
20 completed weeks or more;

21 7. "Certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth" means a
22 certificate issued to record and memorialize the birth of a
23 stillborn child;

1 8. "Fetal death" means death prior to the complete expulsion or
2 extraction from its mother of a product of human conception after a
3 period of gestation as prescribed by the State Board of Health. The
4 death is indicated by the fact that, after such expulsion or
5 extraction, the fetus does not breathe or show any other evidence of
6 life such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord
7 or definite movement of voluntary muscles;

8 ~~7.~~ 9. "Dead body" means an individual who is determined to be
9 dead pursuant to the provisions of the Uniform Determination of
10 Death Act;

11 ~~8.~~ 10. "Final disposition" means the burial, interment,
12 cremation, or other disposition of a dead body or fetus;

13 ~~9.~~ 11. "Physician" means a person who is a member of the class
14 of persons authorized to use the term "physician" pursuant to
15 Section 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

16 ~~10.~~ 12. "Institution" means any establishment, public or
17 private, which provides inpatient medical, surgical or diagnostic
18 care or treatment, or nursing, custodial or domiciliary care, to two
19 or more unrelated individuals, or to which persons are committed by
20 law.

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-311.4 of Title 63, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Missing Angels
2 Act - Christopher and Kendall's Law".

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-311.4a of Title 63, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 A. The State Registrar of Vital Statistics shall establish a
7 certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth to be offered to the
8 parent or parents of a stillborn child. The certificate shall meet
9 all of the requirements provided for in Section 1-311 of Title 63 of
10 the Oklahoma Statutes, and:

11 1. If the place of stillbirth is unknown, a birth certificate
12 shall be filed in the registration district in which the dead fetus
13 was found; and

14 2. If a stillbirth occurs on a moving conveyance, a birth
15 certificate shall be filed in the district in which the stillborn
16 child was first removed from the conveyance.

17 B. A blank space shall be left for the name of a stillborn
18 child on the certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth if the
19 parent or parents of the stillborn child do not wish to provide a
20 name.

21 C. The certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth shall be
22 filed with the designated registrar within seven (7) days following
23 the delivery and prior to cremation or removal of the fetus from the
24 registration district.

1 D. A certificate may be marked as delayed and filed and
2 registered in accordance with Section 1-313 of Title 63 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes when a birth resulting in stillbirth occurring in
4 this state has not been registered within one (1) year after the
5 date of delivery.

6 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
