9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
11 designating certain highways and bridges; requiring
12 placement of markers; providing for codification; and
13 declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The section of State Highway 115 between the junctions of State
19 Highway 49 and State Highway 19 in Comanche and Kiowa Counties shall
20 be designated the "Duty Rowe Scenic Route 115". The Department of
21 Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be placed upon that
22 section of highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The four new bridges on State Highway 32 west of the City of
5 Marietta in Love County crossing the Walnut Bayou shall be
6 designated as the "John Adams and Arlie Harrill Memorial Bridges".
7 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
8 markers to be placed upon those bridges bearing those names.

9 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.20 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge on State Highway 62 south of Haskell, Oklahoma, shall
13 be designated the "Private First Class Cody Montana Carver, U.S.
14 Army 3rd Infantry Division Memorial Bridge". The Department of
15 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
16 upon the bridge bearing that name.

17 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.21 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of State Highway 64 between Muskogee and Keefeton
21 shall be designated the "Representative Jim L. Barker, Speaker of
22 the Oklahoma House of Representatives Memorial Highway". The
23 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
24 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.22 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 9 from Skagg City Road east to the
5 intersection of State Highway 9-A in Pottawatomie County shall be
6 designated the "U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Ruben Rivers Highway". SSG
7 Ruben Rivers was killed in action during World War II on November
8 19, 1944. He was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for his
9 heroic efforts as a member of the 761st Tank Battalion, the first
10 African-American armored unit to serve in combat. In addition to
11 the Medal of Honor, Staff Sergeant Rivers was awarded the Silver
12 Star for previous action with his battalion. The Department of
13 Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be placed upon that
14 section of highway bearing that name.

15 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.23 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The section of Interstate 35 from State Highway 64 (Fir Street)
19 south to State Highway 51 shall be designated the "SPC Ross Hunter
20 Duncan Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
21 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
22 the name.

1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.24 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 105 from I-35 east to the Lincoln
5 County line shall be designated the "OHP Lt. J.C. Burris Memorial
6 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
7 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing the name.

8 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
