10 An Act relating to corrections; amending 57 O.S.  
11 2001, Section 69, which relates to meals for jail  
12 personnel; authorizing meals for correctional  
13 employees upon certain approval; providing for  
14 payment of certain meals from appropriated monies;  
15 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
16 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2001, Section 69, is  
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 69. In order to protect the health and safety of  
21 certain law enforcement personnel and the citizens of this state,  
22 and to provide the state with the benefit of proper security within  
23 the county jails and correctional facilities of this state, all  
24 jailers, jail directors, keepers of the jail, sheriffs, deputies,  
correctional employees, or any other law enforcement personnel

1 working within the county jail facility or correctional facility  
2 ~~may, upon the approval of the sheriff,~~ be served the same meals  
3 served to the prisoners within such county jail or correctional  
4 facility, upon the approval of the sheriff or warden of the  
5 correctional facility. There shall be no cost to the law  
6 enforcement personnel for such meals. The county sheriff or warden  
7 of the correctional facility shall pay for these meals out of the  
8 funds appropriated to the county sheriffs or Department of  
9 Corrections. The county and all of its officers and agents are  
10 hereby prohibited from recouping the cost of such meals either  
11 directly or indirectly or otherwise considering such costs or their  
12 impact when establishing the charges to municipalities for housing  
13 municipal prisoners in the county jail; provided, a municipality may  
14 negotiate the manner of establishing such charges.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

16 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
