8 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
10 designating certain highways and overpasses to honor
11 Colonel Albert Hill, the 929th Troop Carrier Group of
12 the United States Air Force Reserves and the Alton M.
13 Ashworth United States Army Reserve Center, Danny
14 Martinez, Sergeant Buddy Hughie and PFC John Reece,
15 Jr.; providing for codification; and declaring an
16 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.4 of Title 69, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 State Highway 69 from the Shawnee Bypass to Okmulgee Street in
22 Muskogee shall be designated as the "Colonel Albert Hill Highway".
23 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
24 markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.5 of Title 69, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The Muskogee Turnpike from the Shawnee Bypass to Peak Boulevard
5 shall be designated to honor the 929th Troop Carrier Group of the
6 United States Air Force Reserve and the Alton M. Ashworth United
7 States Army Reserve Center. The Department of Transportation shall
8 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
9 those names.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.6 of Title 69, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The portion where State Highways 270 and 271 are one common
14 merged highway in Wister, Oklahoma, and extending approximately five
15 miles directly west of Wister, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
16 "Danny Martinez Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
17 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway
18 bearing that name.

19 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.7 of Title 69, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The overpass located where State Highway 59 and 271 meet at the
23 north end of the Poteau Bypass in Poteau, Oklahoma, shall be
24 designated to honor Sergeant Buddy Hughie. The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
2 on the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.8 of Title 69, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 State Highway 20 between the municipal limits of Pryor and
7 Salina shall be designated as the "PFC John Reece, Jr., Medal of
8 Honor/Purple Heart Memorial Highway". The Department of
9 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
10 on the highway bearing that name.

11 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
