10 An Act relating to public transportation; amending 69
11 O.S. 2001, Section 4035, which relates to retention
12 of certain monies to fund programs; modifying basis
for rate of certain payments; and declaring an
emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 4035, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 4035. For each fiscal year, the Oklahoma Department of
19 Transportation shall retain five percent (5%) of the total amount of
20 monies contained in the Public Transit Revolving Fund and shall use
21 the retained monies to fund new public mass transportation programs,
22 in areas not served by mass transportation as of July 1, 1990, as
23 authorized and determined by the Department. Eligible entities
24 desiring to begin new public mass transportation programs shall

1 submit a request for monies from the Public Transit Revolving Fund
2 to the Department showing the area to be served, the total mileage
3 of the proposed service, and the amount of funding desired. The
4 Department shall allocate the monies to eligible entities within
5 three (3) months of the date of the request for monies from the
6 Public Transit Revolving Fund. New public mass transportation
7 programs shall receive payment at the rate of seventy-five cents
8 (\$0.75) per ~~vehicle-revenue~~ passenger mile. Any retained monies not
9 allocated during the fiscal year shall remain in the Public Transit
10 Revolving Fund to be allocated as provided in this section and
11 Section 4034 of this title.

12 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
