11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Office of the Lieutenant  
13 Governor; making certain appropriations nonfiscal;  
14 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget  
15 procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;  
16 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. Appropriations made by Section 55 of Enrolled House  
20 Bill No. 2276 of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature,  
21 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may  
22 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-  
23 09) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010  
24 (hereafter FY-10). Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only  
through June 30, 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009.

1 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for  
2 FY-10, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
3 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered  
4 only through June 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15,  
5 2010, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
6 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in  
7 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not  
8 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted  
9 for FY-10, after the agency to which the funds have been  
10 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
11 revision removing these funds from the FY-09 budget work program and  
12 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State  
13 Finance.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
