CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Chief Executive Officer; providing budgetary limitations; providing exceptions to the budgetary limitations; making appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse dates; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

2 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
3 each budget category.

4 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
6 upon the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority by law shall
7 be set by the Chief Executive Officer. The salary of the Chief
8 Executive Officer of the Oklahoma Space Industry Development
9 Authority shall not exceed Ninety-one Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-
10 five Dollars (\$91,455.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal
11 year ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Space Industry Development
12 Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject
13 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
14 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
15 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
16 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

20 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Section 134 of Enrolled House
21 Bill No. 2276 of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature,
22 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may
23 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-
24 09) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010

1 (hereafter FY-10). Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only
2 through June 30, 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009.
3 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for
4 FY-10, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
5 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered
6 only through June 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15,
7 2010, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
8 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
9 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not
10 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
11 for FY-10, after the agency to which the funds have been
12 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
13 revision removing these funds from the FY-09 budget work program and
14 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State
15 Finance.

16 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

17 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
