11 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Department of Mental Health
13 and Substance Abuse Services; making an
14 appropriation; stating purpose; exempting
15 appropriation from agency budget and category limits;
16 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget
17 procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;
18 providing an effective date; and declaring an
19 emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
22 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services from any monies not
23 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
24 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of Two

1 Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,150,000.00) or so
2 much thereof as may be necessary for duties.

3 SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
4 subject to fiscal year 2009 agency budget and category limits.

5 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by this act, not including
6 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
7 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09), or may be
8 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
9 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
10 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
11 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
12 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
13 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
14 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
15 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
16 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
17 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
18 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
19 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
20 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
21 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
22 approved by the Office of State Finance.

23 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

1 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
