10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the State Board of Education;
12 making appropriations; stating purposes; exempting
13 appropriations from agency budget and category
14 limits; providing lapse dates; requiring certain
15 budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget
16 procedures; providing an effective date; and
17 declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
20 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars
23 (\$800,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the
24 duties imposed upon the State Board of Education by law.

1 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
2 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
3 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
4 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
5 (\$200,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation
6 to a district with expenditures for legal services for special
7 education litigation in excess of four percent of the district's
8 general fund expenditures for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008.

9 SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be
10 subject to fiscal year 2009 agency budget and category limits.

11 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
12 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09), or may be
14 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
15 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
16 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
17 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
18 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
19 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
20 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
21 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
22 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
23 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
24 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after

1 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
2 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
3 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
4 approved by the Office of State Finance.

5 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

6 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
