10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and
12 Mathematics; requiring expenditure of certain sum for
13 certain purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
14 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
15 measures; providing for duties and compensation of
16 employees; limiting the maximum salary of the
17 Director; providing budgetary limitations; making
18 certain students eligible for certain programs;
19 providing lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting
20 certain budget procedures; providing an effective
21 date; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. Of the funds appropriated in Section 33 of Enrolled
24 Senate Bill No. 334 of the 1st Session of the 51st Oklahoma
Legislature, the sum of One Million Nine Hundred Sixty-eight
Thousand Two Hundred Forty-three Dollars (\$1,968,243.00) shall be
expended for the purpose of developing and offering pilot outreach

1 programs in science and mathematics as directed in Section 1210.404
2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, the Board
4 of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall
5 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

13 The Board of Trustees shall develop outcome-based performance
14 measures for each budget category.

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law shall be
18 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
19 Seventy-five Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-five Dollars (\$75,685.00)
20 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008.
21 The Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2008, shall be subject to the following budgetary
23 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
24 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as

1 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
2 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

5 SECTION 4. Students who are enrolled in a consolidated school
6 district shall be eligible to apply to attend regional pilot
7 outreach programs in science and mathematics as directed in Section
8 1210.404 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes if all or part of the
9 consolidated school district is served by the technology center
10 school district.

11 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by Section 33 of Enrolled Senate
12 Bill No. 334 of the 1st Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature,
13 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may
14 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 (hereafter FY-
15 08), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009
16 (hereafter FY-09). Funds budgeted for FY-08 may be encumbered only
17 through June 30, 2008, and must be expended by November 15, 2008.
18 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2008, and not budgeted for
19 FY-09, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
20 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered
21 only through June 30, 2009. Any funds remaining after November 15,
22 2009, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
23 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
24 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-08, and not

1 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
2 for FY-09, after the agency to which the funds have been
3 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
4 revision removing these funds from the FY-08 budget work program and
5 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State
6 Finance.

7 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007.

8 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
