9 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to the Ethics Commission; requiring
11 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
12 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
13 duties and compensation of employees; providing
14 budgetary limitations; providing lapse dates;
15 requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures;
16 providing an effective date; and declaring an
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, the Ethics
20 Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and
21 amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Ethics Commission by law shall be set by the Executive
6 Director. The Ethics Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30,
7 2008, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
8 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
9 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
10 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
11 the Oklahoma Statutes:

15 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Section 50 of Enrolled Senate
16 Bill No. 334 of the 1st Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature,
17 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may
18 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 (hereafter FY-
19 08) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009
20 (hereafter FY-09). Funds budgeted for FY-08 may be encumbered only
21 through June 30, 2008, and must be expended by November 15, 2008.
22 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2008, and not budgeted for
23 FY-09, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
24 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered

1 only through June 30, 2009. Any funds remaining after November 15,
2 2009, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
3 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
4 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-08, and not
5 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
6 for FY-09, after the agency to which the funds have been
7 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
8 revision removing these funds from the FY-08 budget work program and
9 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State
10 Finance.

11 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007.

12 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
