10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the University Hospitals
12 Authority; providing for duties and compensation of
13 employees; requiring compliance with and providing
14 budgetary limitations; providing lapse dates;
15 requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures;
16 providing an effective date; and declaring an
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not
20 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
21 upon the University Hospitals Authority by law shall be set by the
22 University Hospitals Authority. The University Hospitals Authority
23 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, shall be subject to the
24 following budgetary limitations, except as may be authorized

1 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes:

<u>Budgetary Limitation</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Full-time-equivalent Employees	10.0

5 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by Section 81 of Enrolled Senate
6 Bill No. 334 of the 1st Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature,
7 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may
8 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 (hereafter FY-
9 08), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009
10 (hereafter FY-09). Funds budgeted for FY-08 may be encumbered only
11 through June 30, 2008, and must be expended by November 15, 2008.
12 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2008, and not budgeted for
13 FY-09, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
14 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered
15 only through June 30, 2009. Any funds remaining after November 15,
16 2009, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
17 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
18 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-08, and not
19 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
20 for FY-09, after the agency to which the funds have been
21 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
22 revision removing these funds from the FY-08 budget work program and
23 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State
24 Finance.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007.

2 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
