10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Court of Criminal Appeals;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; authorizing employment of temporary
14 employees; exempting temporary employees from
15 budgetary limitations; providing for the duties and
16 compensation of employees; providing budgetary
17 limitations; providing lapse dates; and requiring and
18 prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an
19 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, the Court
22 of Criminal Appeals shall budget all funds in the following
23 categories and amounts:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
Court Operations	\$3,489,631.00	\$3,756,013.00

1 SECTION 2. The Court of Criminal Appeals is authorized to
2 employ temporary employees as may be necessary to maintain timely
3 disposition of criminal appeal cases. Personnel employed pursuant
4 to the provisions of this section shall be exempt from the
5 limitation on full-time-equivalent employees provided in Section 3
6 of this act.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law shall be set by the Judges
10 of the Court of Criminal Appeals. The Court of Criminal Appeals,
11 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, shall be subject to the
12 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,
13 except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section
14 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

18 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by Section 126 of Enrolled
19 Senate Bill No. 334 of the 1st Session of the 51st Oklahoma
20 Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay
21 purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008
22 (hereafter FY-08), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending
23 June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09). Funds budgeted for FY-08 may be
24 encumbered only through June 30, 2008, and must be expended by

1 November 15, 2008. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2008, and
2 not budgeted for FY-09, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund
3 for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be
4 encumbered only through June 30, 2009. Any funds remaining after
5 November 15, 2009, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for
6 the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be
7 budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-
8 08, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be
9 budgeted for FY-09, after the agency to which the funds have been
10 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
11 revision removing these funds from the FY-08 budget work program and
12 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State
13 Finance.

14 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007.

15 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
