10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to public health and safety;
12 prohibiting the forced implantation of a microchip or
13 other permanent mark; providing exception;
14 authorizing the State Department of Health to impose
15 a fine in certain circumstances; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1430 of Title 63, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. No person, state, county, or local governmental entity or
22 corporate entity may require an individual to undergo the implanting
23 of a microchip or permanent mark of any kind or nature upon the
24 individual, except when provided for under law for the purpose of

1 administrating persons who have been convicted of any offense
2 enumerated under Section 13.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 B. The State Department of Health may impose a fine not to
4 exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) on any person who violates
5 this act. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a
6 separate offense.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
