8 ( public finance - amending 62 O.S., Section 41.5e -  
9 technology plans -

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2001, Section 41.5e, as  
15 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 266, O.S.L. 2006 (62 O.S. Supp.  
16 2007, Section 41.5e), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 41.5e A. No later than July 1 of each year, all  
18 agencies of the executive branch of this state presently using or  
19 contemplating the use of telecommunications and electronic  
20 information technology applications, including, but not limited to,  
21 the use of mainframe computers, minicomputers or microcomputers,  
22 word processing equipment, office automation systems, Internet,  
23 eGovernment, or contracts for information technology services and  
24 equipment, shall annually submit to the Information Services

1 Division a one-year operations plan, which shall include as a  
2 minimum:

3 1. An overview of major projects and objectives;  
4 2. Cost per defined category of hardware, software, services  
5 and personnel;

6 3. An assurance of compliance with state standards on  
7 accessibility of information technology for individuals with  
8 disabilities developed in accordance with Section 41.5t of this  
9 title; and

10 4. Such other information as the Information Services Division  
11 may require for analysis and consolidation into a statewide  
12 telecommunications and electronic information technology plan.

13 B. No agency of the executive branch of this state shall enter  
14 into any agreement for the acquisition, development, or enhancement  
15 of application systems software or for the acquisition of electronic  
16 information technology equipment or peripheral devices, including  
17 Internet and eGovernment, whether or not connected to such  
18 equipment, unless the cost of such acquisition, development, or  
19 enhancement has been included in the plan for the agency. The  
20 Information Services Division upon review of an information  
21 technology and telecommunication plan for the agency, shall submit  
22 in writing, in either printed or electronic form, to the Governor,  
23 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro  
24 Tempore of the Senate its findings and recommendations on all

1 proposed new and expanded programs and expenditures for personnel  
2 and the purchase or acquisition of equipment, hardware, software,  
3 accessories, or services thereto, including but not limited to  
4 leases, rentals or lease-purchase, indicating that the associated  
5 cost meet or comply with Section 41.5a of this title.

6 C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the  
7 telecommunications network known as OneNet whether said network is  
8 governed or operated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher  
9 Education or any other state entity assigned responsibility for  
10 OneNet.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2008.
