12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election
14 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
15 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
16 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State
18 Election Board by law.

19 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election
20 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special
21 Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of _____ Dollars
22 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be required to pay the necessary
23 expenses of holding elections.

1 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State
 2 Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
 3 and amounts:

10 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 12 upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the State
 13 Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the State Election
 14 Board shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
 15 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
 16 The State Election Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009,
 17 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
 18 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
 19 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
 20 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
 21 Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 5. The appropriations made by this act shall not be
2 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
3 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)

6 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
