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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the J.M. Davis  
15 Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
16 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much  
18 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
19 J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the J.M.  
21 Davis Memorial Commission shall budget all funds in the following  
22 categories and amounts:

1 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
3 upon the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law shall be set by the  
4 Chief Administrative Officer of the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission.  
5 The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed  
6 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable  
7 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The J.M. Davis  
8 Memorial Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall  
9 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
10 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
11 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
12 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
13 Statutes:

17 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
18 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be  
20 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).  
21 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
22 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds  
23 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall  
24 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal

1 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June  
2 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse  
3 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
4 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
5 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay  
6 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after  
7 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
8 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
9 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been  
10 approved by the Office of State Finance.

11 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

12 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
