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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
15 Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
18 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
19 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Office  
21 of the Attorney General is authorized to transfer an amount not to  
22 exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) from  
23 the Office of the Attorney General's Evidence Fund (700 Fund),  
24 created by Section 19 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes to the

1 Office of the Attorney General's Revolving Fund (200 Fund) created  
2 by Section 20 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Office  
4 of the Attorney General is authorized to transfer an amount not to  
5 exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) from the Office of the  
6 Attorney General's Evidence Fund (700 Fund), created by Section 19  
7 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes to the Office of the Attorney  
8 General's Revolving Fund (200 Fund) created by Section 20 of Title  
9 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Office  
11 of the Attorney General shall budget all funds in the following  
12 categories and amounts:

1 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse  
2 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
3 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
4 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay  
5 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after  
6 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
7 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
8 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been  
9 approved by the Office of State Finance.

10 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

11 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
