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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State

15 Bureau of Investigation from any monies not otherwise appropriated

16 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal

17 year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars

18 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties

19 imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the

21 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall budget all funds in the

22 following categories and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law shall be set
11 by the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation. The
12 salary of the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
13 shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable
14 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma
15 State Bureau of Investigation for the fiscal year ending June 30,
16 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
17 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
18 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
19 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
20 the Oklahoma Statutes:

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1 SECTION 4. Of the amount appropriated to the Oklahoma State
2 Bureau of Investigation by Section 1 of this act, a maximum of Fifty
3 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) may be transferred to an agency
4 special account for the purpose of purchasing evidence items, paying
5 fees to informers or special employees, paying expenses incurred in
6 the prosecution and defense of civil actions, and paying other
7 expenses as incurred under the Evidence Fund activity in trying to
8 apprehend and convict violators of the laws of the state. The
9 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall report income to the
10 Evidence Fund annually pursuant to the provisions of Sections 41.7c
11 and 41.29 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 SECTION 5. Of the total number of full-time-equivalent employee
13 positions authorized for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
14 in this act, eleven (11.0) shall perform duties in accordance with
15 the Criminal Intelligence Unit and nine (9.0) shall perform duties
16 in accordance with the Criminal Records Audit Unit. The
17 continuation of these full-time-equivalent employees is contingent
18 upon sufficient agency revolving funds to support them.

19 SECTION 6. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of
20 Investigation may request that the receipt and expenditure of
21 unanticipated federal funds after July 1, 2008, be exempt from
22 expenditure limitations, provided that any such funds are used for
23 operations and shall be included in the agency's budget work
24 program.

1 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by this act, not including
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
5 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
6 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
7 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
10 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
17 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
18 approved by the Office of State Finance.

19 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

20 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
