13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
15 State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise
16 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars
18 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
19 imposed upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law.

20 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
21 State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise
22 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars
24 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties

1 imposed upon the Commission on County Government Personnel Education
2 and Training. The appropriation made in this section shall be
3 expended exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be
4 transferable.

5 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Rural Economic
6 Action Plan Fund of the State Treasury from any monies not otherwise
7 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
8 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars
9 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the
10 provisions of Sections 2006 through 2013 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma
11 Statutes.

12 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State
13 Auditor and Inspector shall budget all funds in the following
14 categories and amounts:

22 SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not
23 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law shall be set by the

1 State Auditor and Inspector. The State Auditor and Inspector for
2 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the
3 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
4 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
5 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
6 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

10 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
11 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
12 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be
13 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
14 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
15 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
16 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
17 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
18 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
19 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
20 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
21 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
22 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
23 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
24 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
