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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
15 Department of Veterans Affairs from any monies not otherwise  
16 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_ Dollars  
18 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
19 imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
21 Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall budget all funds in  
22 the following categories and amounts:

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
9 upon the Director by law shall be set by the Director. The salary  
10 of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
11 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.  
12 The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
14 limitations, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions  
15 of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

19 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
20 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
21 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be  
22 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).  
23 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
24 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds

1 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall  
2 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
3 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June  
4 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse  
5 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
6 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
7 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay  
8 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after  
9 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
10 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
11 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been  
12 approved by the Office of State Finance.

13 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

14 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
