14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 DEPARTMENT OF MINES

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
17 Mines from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General  
18 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June  
19 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department  
21 of Mines by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
23 Department of Mines shall budget all funds in the following  
24 categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Mines by law shall be set by the Executive Director of the Department of Mines. The salary of the Executive Director of the Department of Mines shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Department of Mines for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).  
2 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
3 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds  
4 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall  
5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
6 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June  
7 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse  
8 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay  
11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after  
12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
13 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
14 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been  
15 approved by the Office of State Finance.

16 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

17 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
