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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
17 Environmental Quality from any monies not otherwise appropriated
18 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
19 year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
20 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
21 upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
23 Department of Environmental Quality shall budget all funds in the
24 following categories and amounts:

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law shall be set by
14 the Executive Director of the Department of Environmental Quality.
15 The salary of the Executive Director of the Department of
16 Environmental Quality shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
17 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
18 The Department of Environmental Quality for the fiscal year ending
19 June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
20 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
21 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
22 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
23 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

3 SECTION 4. The Department of Environmental Quality shall
4 provide from any funds available contractual services to the
5 Oklahoma Rural Water Association for technical assistance programs
6 to rural water system operators.

7 SECTION 5. The Department of Environmental Quality is directed
8 to expend an amount not to exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) from
9 solid waste fee collections by the Department for the purpose of
10 compensation, benefits and other necessary expenses during the
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, associated with the employees from
12 the Oklahoma and Tulsa City-County environmental programs, as
13 authorized by law.

14 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
15 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be
17 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
18 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
19 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
20 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
21 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
22 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
23 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
24 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

1 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
2 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
3 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
4 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
5 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
6 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
7 approved by the Office of State Finance.

8 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

9 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
