8 An Act relating to schools; authorizing school
9 personnel to report certain conduct of students to
10 appropriate school officials and law enforcement;
11 amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 6-101.48, as amended
12 by Section 2, Chapter 205, O.S.L. 2005 (70 O.S. Supp.
13 2007, Section 6-101.48), which relates to persons and
14 businesses having contracts with or performing
15 services for schools or school districts; modifying
16 requirements for certain signed statement; providing
17 for codification; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-154 of Title 70, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 Whenever a student directs any violent, obscene, indecent, or
23 profane language toward any superintendent, principal, teacher or
24 other school support personnel, while attending school or any
school-sponsored activity, school-sanctioned event or school-
sanctioned athletic event, the superintendent, principal, teacher or
other school support personnel shall have the authority to

1 immediately report the matter to a designated school official who
2 may then contact local law enforcement.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 6-101.48, as
4 amended by Section 2, Chapter 205, O.S.L. 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2007,
5 Section 6-101.48), is amended to read as follows:

6 Section 6-101.48 A. No person or business having a contract
7 with a school or school district to perform work on a full-time or
8 part-time basis that would otherwise be performed by school district
9 employees shall allow any employee to work on school premises if
10 ~~such~~ the employee is convicted in this state, the United States or
11 another state of any felony offense unless ten (10) years has
12 elapsed since the date of the criminal conviction or the employee
13 has received a presidential or gubernatorial pardon for the criminal
14 offense.

15 B. Every person or business performing services not subject to
16 subsection A of this section on the property of a school or school
17 district shall at the time of contracting be required to sign a
18 statement declaring that no employee working on school premises
19 under the authority of ~~such~~ the business is currently registered
20 under the provisions of the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act
21 ~~and that the business is not in violation of the provisions of this~~
22 ~~section.~~ Compliance with this statute shall be required of the
23 person or private business, and there shall be no obligation placed
